OUR COMMITMENT TO PEOPLE, NATURE AND IMPACT



- **KES 5M grant secured for 2026**

EAST AFRICA



- **USD 50,000 grant agreement finalised for 2026**
- **Focus on sustaining tsetse fly control and ecological readiness for wildlife restoration**
- **Expansion of the community-led conservation model, including local employment and monitoring systems**
- **Scaling of women-led poultry enterprise, supporting livelihoods and food security**
- **Rhinos successfully translocated to Kidepo in 2026, marking the return of a species absent since 1983**



Maasai Mara Conservancies



- **Initiated cadastral mapping and land information systems to improve land ownership clarity and governance**
- **Completed rhino reintroduction feasibility study for Ol Chorro Conservancy**
- **Provided group life insurance for ranger welfare across four conservancies**
- **Supporting conservancies through infrastructure planning and operational engagement**
- **Exploring alternative financing and livelihood models aligned with community priorities**
- **Advancing discussions on long-term land security, including a potential land trust model**

SUBSIDIARY PROJECTS

Platinum Credit Kenya



In Q1 2026, Platinum Credit Kenya focused on Environmental and Community Development initiatives.



ENVIRONMENTAL

Through the LANSRET (Landscape Repair and Transformation Program), Platinum Kenya **planted 16,500 seedlings**, both indigenous and exotic trees, across various public institutions, contributing to a 30,000-seedling target this year to benefit more than 5,000 people.



COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

Platinum Kenya committed to **a full-year sponsorship for 23 young basketball players** in Eldoret.

Furthermore, they engaged the correctional service in an **initiative that reached 1,000 beneficiaries** by **providing sports equipment and hygiene supplies** to both male and female prisons across Kenya.



Platinum Credit Uganda



In Q1 2026, Platinum Credit Uganda focused on Environmental initiatives.



ENVIRONMENTAL

Platinum Uganda sponsored the **Run for the Nile** initiative in Jinja, contributing to efforts to **protect key water ecosystems**, including the River Nile and Lake Victoria, from plastic pollution.

In Q1 2026, Platinum Credit Tanzania focused on Health initiatives.



HEALTH

Through the **Substance Use Prevention Education (SUPE)** Program, Platinum Tanzania supported local hospitals by facilitating staff-led blood donations and providing **essential medical supplies**.



Premier Credit Kenya



In Q1 2026, Premier Credit Kenya focused on Environmental and Health initiatives.



ENVIRONMENT

Premier Kenya planted **900 fruit and shade trees** across Tumaini Junior Academy in Matuu and Everest Star Academy in Karatina, supporting a greener learning environment for a total of **525 students**.



HEALTH

Premier Kenya supported **life-saving heart surgeries** for **41 children** in Nairobi by contributing to the Heart to Heart Foundation fundraising initiative.
