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LEGACY PROJECTS



 **THE LAMU MARINE
CONSERVATION TRUST**

- **4** multi-agency patrols conducted across Kipungani, Ngoi and Kinyika
- **206** fishers and boat owners licensed, covering 60% of BMU villages
- **1** Community Intelligence Team trained, strengthening community-led surveillance; **10** members trained
- **2** community sensitisation meetings held, across **10** BMUs
- **2 of 4** planned BMU patrol chairman training sessions delivered ; **10** rangers trained
- **10** BMU Patrol Committee leaders

- **50 Community Conservation Champions recruited** and trained (**25** Kakamega, **25** South West Mau)
- **2 Champion inductions** and refresher trainings delivered across Kakamega and SW Mau
- **Strong stakeholder buy-in** secured from CFAs, KFS, KWS and local administration
- Multiple **community barazas** held across both landscapes, introducing the CCC model
- **Systems established** for ongoing Champion supervision and reporting
- **2 coordination meetings** held with KFS, KWS, CFAs and local administration to strengthen Champion supervision



RHINO ARK



- **Group Life Insurance and WIBA cover secured for 212 members across 5 conservancies** (Enonkishu, Mbokishi, Ol Chorro, Mara North, Lemek)
- **Rhino reintroduction feasibility study completed** for Ol Chorro with a specialist translocation adviser identified to lead KWS coordination
- **Cadastral mapping system completed**, digitising land parcels and ownership across Mbokishi and Enonkishu Conservancies
- **Northern Mara Tourism Infrastructure concept** presented to and supported by the Enonkishu Board

- **2 VSLAs** and **1 demonstration plot** planned

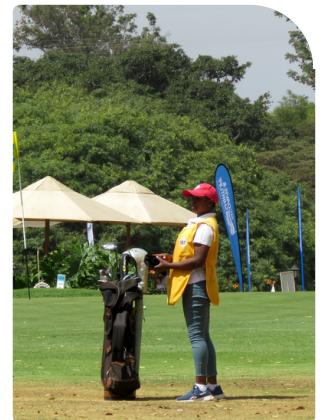

TARGETED INITIATIVES



- **Suqoon:** Supported a 6-month program focused on promoting healthy ageing.

In Q2 2026, Platinum Credit Kenya focused on Health, Education and Community Development initiatives.

Education

Installed a **solar power system** at Machakos School for the Deaf, strengthening school programmes.

Donated **uniforms and branded kits** at Isiolo Barracks Secondary School and Dori Girls Senior School.

Donated **sanitary towels** and **menstrual hygiene education** to **1,033 girls** at Nairobi River Comprehensive School.



Community Development

Donated **sports equipment and uniforms** to police and prison teams across counties, promoting teamwork and wellbeing.

Donated **warmth packages to elderly individuals** and essential **food supplies** to palliative care patients during the Easter season.

Enabled continued learning for prison inmates and staff at Kerugoya GK Prison through the **donation of stationery and learning materials**.

Provided **747 female inmates** and their children at **Lang'ata Women's Prison** with **menstrual hygiene and essential care items**.



Health

Improved **access to clean water** and sanitation for **Kakamega Primary & JSS School** through the **donation of a 10,000L water tank**.

Education

Constructed a **three-classroom block** at Bugolombe Primary School to create a better learning environment for **460 pupils**.



Community Development

Contributed to the construction of the **Lweza COU Community Centre**, extending its reach to women, children, and youth.

Funded the construction of a **patient waiting shed** at Nsambya Police Health Centre IV to enhance the facility's efforts to achieve international accreditation.

Health

Donated to the ZIA Fundraising Golf Tournament to improve the **children's ward** at the **University Teaching Hospital (UTH)** and create a better healing environment for young patients and their families.

In Q2 2026, Premier Credit Kenya focused on Environment, Health, Education and Community Development initiatives.

Environment

Collaborated with Tembwo Junior Academy to plant **418 indigenous fruit trees** in Sotik, Kenya. The initiative engaged **134 pupils and 8 teachers**, promoting environmental stewardship and providing long-term nutritional and ecological benefits.

Funded full year **Occupational Therapy** for **20 children** living with **Cerebral Palsy**.



Community Development

Supported **64 children** through **food donations** and **improved working conditions** at Karai Police Station.

Donated **3 laptops and a printer** to **Nairobi County Offices**, strengthening public service delivery for **over 1,000 citizens** served daily.

Collaborated with Strathmore Business School to deliver a **financial literacy programme to 34 school proprietors** in Eldoret.
