LEGACY PROJECTS



70 hectares of degraded indigenous forest rehabilitated and under active maintenance



4 full-time community scouts employed for daily maintenance and site security (2 per site)



50 farmers engaged in the beekeeping livelihood program



22 indigenous community members involved in herbal product development



80 churches engaged in community conservation outreach



40 community tree nurseries established



46 schools participating in the conservation education curriculum



77,000 seedlings planted in Tirgoi



7 forest security outposts constructed by Rhino Ark across the SW Mau ecosystem



1,000 tsetse fly traps deployed across the Kidepo Valley Rhino Sanctuary



9 local community members (Ik and Dodoth) trained and employed for ongoing monitoring and maintenance



33 months of trap monitoring and maintenance are planned



Train 60 women on efficient poultry farming techniques and financial literacy; initially identified 30 women who will each be farming 20 chicks

20 Data Collectors trained (2 from each of 10 villages) using digital tools.



10 BMUs (Beach Management Units) targeted for capacity-building and governance training.



300+ Community Members engaged in waste management and recycling initiatives.



~300 Children reached through LAMCOT's education programs.

PLATINUM UG



Platinum Credit Uganda led impactful initiatives in Q1 2025, focusing on environmental sustainability and community empowerment.

Education Impact

Restored **21.122 hectares** of West Bugwe Central Forest Reserve, surpassing the 20-hectare target, by planting indigenous species like *Spathodia Campanulata* and *Milicia excelsa*.

Supported the **Run for the Nile** marathon in Jinja, raising funds to plant 6,000 trees, establish 5 nursery beds, install plastic traps in Lake Victoria, and develop a digital tree-monitoring platform.

Community Development

Engaged over **250 community members** at the West Bugwe project launch in Syaule village, fostering local ownership.

Mobilized 20 staff among 1,000+ participants in the Run for the Nile, boosting environmental awareness.

Promoted economic opportunities through beekeeping enterprises and local labour advocacy.

Environmental Impact

Celebrating staff member Immaculate Akareut for securing **1st runner-up** in the 10km Run for the Nile, showcasing individual excellence.

Platinum Credit Kenya focused on health, education, and agricultural empowerment across diverse communities.

Health and Education Impact

Distributed over **500 sanitary towels** to girls at Mororo, Mumbuni, Ngucui, and Kiptenden schools, supporting menstrual health.

Provided exercise books to **500+ students**, enhancing learning resources.

Donated a **5000L water tank** to Kitise Secondary School in Kathonzweni.

Community Development

Empowered communities in Garissa, Embu, Wanguru, and Bomet through the Girl Child and Boy Child Initiative.

Agricultural Empowerment

Procured **300 Knapsack sprayers** to support farmers, promoting sustainable agricultural practices.
